Transportation rules for YOUR safety!

- All vehicles must obey the speed limit, which is 5 mph on the grounds.
- The blacktop boulevard is for pedestrians walking, golf carts, and people movers. Please pay attention to the signs at both ends of the boulevard and go the right direction. The south street is for going to Friendship Hall and the north street is for heading back towards River Oaks. Walkers are on the outside of the one-way; golf carts and other propelled vehicles are on the inside of the one-way.
- For those of you with golf carts, please remember that people have the right away, not the golf cart. Please don't allow people to stand on the back of your golf cart while driving - be safe!
- Cars or pickups will not travel the main boulevard at any time during the rally. The only exception will be for Winnebago Industries maintenance vehicles, vendor services vehicles, or entertainment vehicles, which must have a special vehicle pass. Car or motorcycle show/cruise will also be permitted.
- People movers will be available for the rest of pre-rally from 8 a.m.-7 p.m. and during rally week from 8 a.m. until after the entertainment each evening. They will pick you up and deliver you to the head of your row.
